


How to use Open Access-Resources with the Macromedia Catalog

1. Access the discovery system (Macromedia Catalog) via the library homepage.
2. Open Access resources are discoverable and accessible through the Macromedia Catalog:
 - » a) Perform a search, e.g. "Iceland".
 - » b) Open access hits are distinctly marked.



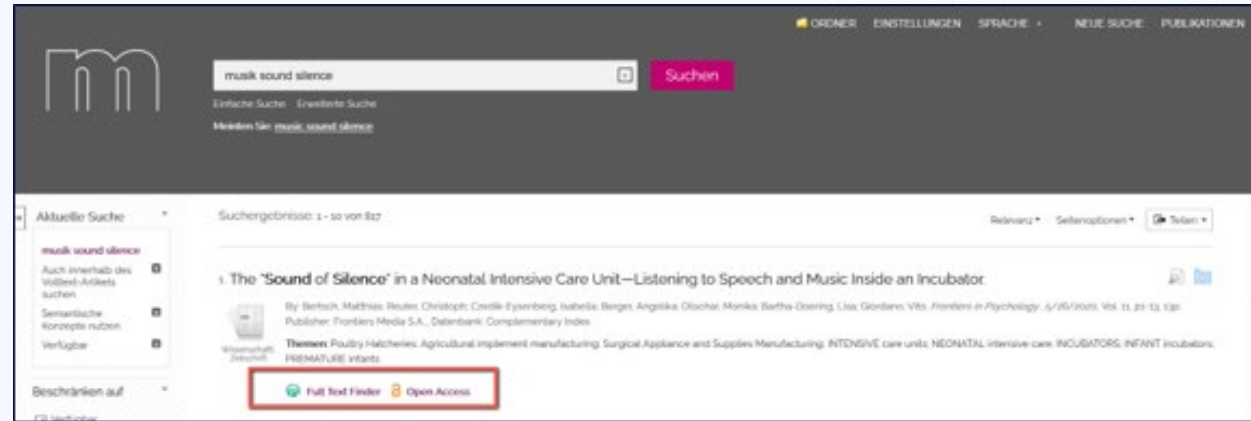

» **b)** Clicking on "Full Text Finder" gives the option to select a provider of the article.

» **c)** The article can be accessed by clicking on one of the (here) four providers.

Note: Clicking on "Open Access" would take you directly to the first of the links in the screenshot, from where the pdf can be downloaded.
